Nursing (2 Years Degree Course) affiliated with **Himachal Pradesh University** and **approved by Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi, Himachal Pradesh Nurses Registration Council (HPNRC) Shimla & Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), Shimla.** Lord Mahavira Nursing College looks forward to incorporating Post graduate nursing courses also.

GENERAL NURSING & MIDWIFERY (GNM)

DURATION: - Three Years

Seats Available: - 40 Seats

ADMISSION: - The Admission of GNM course will be as per guidelines of Indian Nursing Council (INC) and D.M.E.R. (Director Medical Education & Research, Himachal Pradesh).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GNM: -

1. No age bar for this course.
2. Minimum education
 - a. 10+2 class passed with any stream.
 - b. 10+2 passed in Arts (Mathematics, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Study, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Physiology, Philosophy) from there recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent board.
3. The student should be medically fit.

METHOD OF SELECTION: -

1. Eligible candidates are selected on the basis of merit and counselling conducted by D.M.E.R. and HPNRC and other members of the selection committee for State Quota Seats at Shimla.
2. For the Management Quota seatcounseling is conducted in the Lord Mahavira Nursing College by the selection committee.

B.SC. NURSING (BASIC)

DURATION: -Four Years

Seats Available: - 40 Seats

ADMISSION: - **AMRU Mandi Entrance is compulsory for admission.** Only those Female Children of Bonafide Himachali who qualified the Entrance Test will be considered in order of merit of the Entrance Test for admission to B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course in Nursing Colleges subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as contained in the Prospectus. The admission process to B.Sc. Nursing (Basic) is conducted by guidelines of Himachal Pradesh University (HPU) with D.M.E.R. and Indian Nursing Council (INC).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR B.SC. NURSING: -

1. The age of the candidates should be between 17 to 35 years as on 31st December, as recorded in the matriculation certificate. However, upper age can be relaxable by 5 years in the case of SC/ST candidates.
2. A candidate should have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination from H.P. Board of School Education/AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or any other Board/University established by law in India in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually with 45% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination will be 40% instead of 45% as stated above. Provided further that English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc.(Nursing) course.
3. The candidate who appeared in 10+2 examination and their result is not yet declared may also apply for this test, but their admission will be made if they fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in the prospectus at the time of the 1st round of counseling.
4. The candidate should be medically fit.

Method of Selection: -

Entrance Test: -The Entrance Test shall consist of one written paper only in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English (including General Knowledge/current affairs) in accordance with the syllabi of studies based on NCERT books of the academic session conducted by the Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education in the year of the Entrance Test. The medium of examination shall be English. The question paper will have 100 (One Hundred) MCQ objective type questions which include 25 questions in Biology, 25 questions in Physics, 25 Questions in Chemistry, 15 questions in English and 10 questions in General Knowledge. The duration of Entrance Test will be 2 hours.

Selection is done on the basis of ranking and other eligibility criteria. Counselling is conducted by Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), D.M.E.R. and other members of the selection committee for state and management quota seats. For Management Quota Seats registration and counseling is done in the Lord Mahavira Nursing College, Nalagarh.

Note:

1. No fees will be charged by the private Nursing Institutions for hospital attachment from the candidates belonging to BPL/IRDP families admitted under State/Management Quota and their tuition fees shall be Rs. 20,000/-. Similarly, their admission fees would be Rs. 2,000/- only.
2. Other dues such as mess, transport and miscellaneous incidental expenses shall be charged on the actual basis by the Institution.
3. Selected candidates shall have to pay of Rs. 10,000/- only as advance fee at the time of counseling which will be adjusted later on in annual fee by the college concerned.

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing

Duration: - Two Years

Seats Available: - 20 Seats

Admission: - Admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree course shall be made on the basis of merit of the Entrance Test to be conducted by the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla for which the female candidates only are eligible subject to fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- a) The candidates should be registered as registered Nurse/Midwife (RN/RM) with H.P. State Nurses Registration Council, Shimla at the time of counseling.
- b) The candidate must have passed 10+2 and its equivalent examination from recognized Board/University established by Law in India with minimum 45% aggregate marks. For SC/ST/OBC candidates the required percentage of aggregate marks will be 40%.
- c) The candidate must have obtained 50% marks in General Nursing & Midwifery from the School/Institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council/Himachal Pradesh Nurses Registration Council.
- d) The distribution of seats between In-Service and Direct candidates will be made in the ratio of 70:30. However, 200 points vertical reservation roster will be applied afresh for distribution of seats among General, SC, ST and OBC categories and no horizontal reservation roster will be applied.

For In-Service Quota Seats:

- a) In-Service quota seats to be filled up by In-Service regularly appointed Nursing Cadre candidates of Govt. of H.P.

For Direct Quota Seats: Direct quota seats will be available for open competition from amongst:

- a) The Bonafide Himachali/Domicile candidates/Children of H.P. Govt. employees and employees of Autonomous Bodies wholly or partially financed by the Himachal Pradesh Government, who have done their GNM course from GNM Schools/Institutions anywhere in India duly recognized by the Indian Nursing Council/H.P. State Nurses Registration Council.

Note: For filling up Direct Seats under Management Quota in Private Nursing Colleges in State of Himachal Pradesh, there will be no domicile requirement. Under this quota, both Himachali and Non-Himachali interested candidates can compete in the entrance test subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as prescribed in the prospectus.

- b) The age of candidates should be between 17 to 35 years as on 31st December, as recorded in the matriculation certificate. However, upper age can be relaxable by 5 years in the case of SC/ST candidates.

Method of Selection: -

Entrance Test: -The admission to the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course shall be on the basis of Entrance Test to be conducted by the Himachal Pradesh University at Shimla. The examination shall consist of one written paper only in the subjects mentioned hereunder in accordance with the syllabi of GNM studies. The medium of examination shall be English. The merit is prepared and counseling is conducted by a selection committee comprising of members from H.P.U., D.M.E.R., H.P.N.R.C. and other members from nursing colleges.

Note:

1. Other dues such as mess, transport and miscellaneous incidental expenses shall be charged on the actual basis by the institution.
2. Selected candidates shall have to pay of Rs. 10,000/- only as advance fee at the time of counseling which will be adjusted later on in annual fee by the college concerned.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS

1. Attendance at the prayer meeting is compulsory.
2. Students must always be in possession of their Identity Card.
3. An affidavit will be submitted to the institution to ensure that student will not participate in any strike, dharna or demonstration of any kind. The problem, if any faced by the students can be shared with the Student Nursing Association (SNA) meeting in the presence of SNA advisor. The student violating the same may be expelled from the training.
4. Students are not allowed to keep a mobile phone with them in the College, Hostel Campus & Hospital.
5. Students must not give any gift to any employee of the Institute/Hostel/Mess or Canteen.
6. Students should maintain cleanliness in the campus.
7. No student is allowed to involve the name of the Institute in any publication or outside activities without the prior permission of the Principal.
8. Students are expected not to use cosmetics, wear heavy jewelry, anklets, gaudy dresses, skirts, skin tight or revealing clothes.

GENERAL DISCIPLINARY RULES:

The following rules will be taken into consideration while granting internal assessment in various examinations by the Head of the Department.

a) ATTENDANCE:

Every student is required to attend punctually at the hours notified for lectures and practical classes. A student who is late may not be allowed to enter the lecture hall or practical hall. If the student does not attend classes continuously for 3 month without information/valid reason her admission will stand cancelled.

b) CLASS ROOM

- i. Immediately after assembly of the class the roll call will be called and presence and absence of any student will be marked by the Teacher. Any misbehavior in the classroom will be reported to the Principal for further necessary action.
- ii. Students are not permitted to remain in the lecture room except at the prescribed hours of the lectures.
- iii. Mobile telephones are not allowed inside the college campus and class room.

c) EXAMINATION

- i. Students are not allowed to take into the examination hall text books, notes or manuscript of any kind.
- ii. Any student found infringing the rules or having recourse to unfair means will be expelled from the examination and the matter reported to the Principal for taking further action.

d) LEAVE

- i. The trainee will not be entitled for any kind of leave except prescribed vacations and leave having prior sanction of the training In-charge. No leave will be granted when examination is due.
- ii. In all cases leave taken will be at the students own risk so far as the percentage of attendance is concerned and even medical certificate will not be condone a deficiency in attendance for a University examination.
- iii. Students must not leave the station without the permission of the Principal.

e) MISCELLANEOUS

- i. Every student will wish his teacher on the occasion of her first meeting in the College or outside.
- ii. Students are required to observe order and quietness at all times in the College.
- iii. No game of any sort to be played during the hours allotted to lectures or class.
- iv. Smoking and use of liquor within the College premises including Hostel is prohibited, and the defaulter will be rusticated.
- v. All irregularities, neglect of duties and breach of discipline are brought to the notice of the Principal by the Professors/Readers under whom the students are working.
- vi. In dealing with any offence in college/hostel, the Principal may decide whether it is to be met with; any apology, verbal or written, or fine or suspension of scholarship or expulsion from the college/hostel.

f) The Principal is competent to remit the fine imposed by her.

- i. The decision of the Principal in all cases shall be final.
- ii. All students are required to wear prescribed dress code and use of gaudy dress is prohibited.
- iii. No association can be formed in the college without prior permission of the head of institution.
- iv. No student is permitted to write anything on the blackboard unless asked by the teachers to do so.

Hostel Rules

Each hosteller shall be responsible for following faithfully the following rules.

1. No mobiles are permitted in the premises; if found the phone will not be returned to the student.
2. Do not keep any gold jewelry, valuable articles or large sums of money in the hostel. Authorities will not be responsible for any loss.
3. Hostellers are responsible for cleanliness & good upkeep of rooms. Every Saturdays, rooms will be inspected by faculty/ warden.
4. Students are not allowed to conduct meetings/strikes in the hostel. In any case, any student is found guilty; she will be expelled from college and hostel.
5. Hostel attendants are under control of the warden. No person is to be sent out for personal work without permission of the warden.
6. No electric appliance like heater, iron, TV, heat converter, electric rod and mobile charger is allowed in the room. If found guilty the concerned hosteller will be fined Rs. 500/- per item.
7. The room of any hosteller is liable to be inspected by the authorities including warden at any time of day and night.
8. Students are directed to follow study period strictly and they are not allowed to go to other rooms during this period.
9. All lights must be put off by 11.00 P.M. and all lights and fans must be switched off when leaving the room, otherwise fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be charged.
10. Hostellers must submit passport size photographs of three relatives for making identity cards so that they can visit the hostel. The visitors must present the identity cards at the hostel entrance and make the necessary entry in the register kept for the purpose.
11. Only 1 Special Leave and 9 Sick Leaves are allowed per year.
12. Only 1 Outing and 1 Night Pass are allowed per month with prior permission.
13. No hosteller will remain absent from hostel without the written permission of warden/Class-in charge.
14. Every hosteller should make an entry in the departure register before leaving the hostel during night pass or outing.
15. Time for leaving the hostel is 6:00 AM (in Summer), 7:00 AM (in Winter)
16. Time of returning to the hostel is 6:00 PM (in Summer) and 5:00 PM (in Winter)
17. Main Gate will be locked at 8.00 PM.

Anti-Ragging Rules

Every student of the College is informed that under the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh and the rules framed by the University there under vide Ordinance 22.17 ragging is completely prohibited. Any student found involved in ragging will be summarily expelled from the College and legal proceedings under Criminal law shall be initiated against her. Further, an affidavit has to be given by the student and her parents/local guardian that she will not indulge in ragging at the time of her admission and thereafter during her tenure of completion of the Nursing Course.

PROCEDURE FOR FORWARDING AN APPLICATION: -

The Candidates seeking admission to G.N.M., Basic B.Sc. Nursing and Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course should apply on prescribed application form attached at the end of the prospectus in their own handwriting.

Documents required at the time of submitting an application for registration: -

1. Filled prescribed application form.
2. Attested photocopy of birth certificate/Matriculation/10th as age proof.
3. Certificate of having passed the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 or its equivalent examination along with details of marks in each subject.
4. A Certificate of good conduct/character from the Principal of the School/Institution last attended followed by a separate Character Certificate from the Tehsildar/Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the area concerned if applicable.
5. Domicile certificate of H.P. Bonafide.
6. A certificate of particular reserved/sub-reserved category (SC/ST, OBC etc.) issued by the Tehsildar/Sub-Divisional Magistrate of the area concerned.
7. Passport size attested photographs.
8. Migration certificate if applicable.
9. Hostel Application Form.
10. Medical Examination Certificate.
11. Gap Certificate if applicable.

Facilities

1. Faculty: - A team of well qualified and experienced nursing teachers with P.hd B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing and with required experience are working on various posts like Principal, Vice-Principal, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Lecturer and Clinical Instructor.

2. College Building and Class Rooms:-The College has three story building. The class rooms are well ventilated with modern facilities like overhead projectors to enhance the presentation of academic exercises. There are Audio Visual aids, T.V., DVD, Slide projectors, sound system, models and charts for the use of students & faculty members.



3. Transportation: - College buses are available to take the students to affiliated hospitals for clinical experience and community health nursing in the rural and urban areas.



4. Parent Hospital: College has its own 50 bedded Multi-specialty Hospital with Operation Theatre, ICU, Lithotripsy Unit, Endoscopy, CT Scan, X-Ray Unit and Modern Equipment. Another own 100 bedded hospital at Baddi is newly built and started functioning students are posted in this hospital for clinical experience.



5. Nursing Foundation Lab: -To provide practical training of nursing procedures to the students the demonstrations given on the mannequins with proper equipment's in the lab. The lab is equipped with beds, adult & child female and male mannequins. It consists all the essential equipment needed for the demonstration & practice of nursing procedures for students.

6. Community Health Nursing Lab: - It consists of community health nursing bags, models, health teaching charts, audio-visual aids and records like a family folder, infant, toddlers & pre-school child cards, antenatal, post-natal cards, geriatric cards and cards for nursing mothers.



7. Pre-Clinical Lab: - Anatomy & Physiology Lab with the skeleton, bones, adult body model with organs, models on heart, lungs, ear, brain, kidney and other models are displayed in the lab to facilitate learning. A number of charts on anatomy & physiology of various systems are available for teaching students. Microscopes, slides and other material are available in a microbiology lab. Essential chemicals and charts are also available in a biochemistry lab.



8. Nutrition Lab: - It consists of gas chulahas, gas cylinder, tables, utensils for the cooking store and water & washing facilities to enable the student to do nutrition practical and prepare some therapeutic diet in order to learn dietary requirement for vulnerable groups and in fever or special disease conditions.



9. Midwifery and Obstetrics and Child Health Nursing Lab: - Number of models like full body, half body, fetus and skulls are available to facilitate learning of concepts and practical training of students. A number of charts along with other equipment's & instruments related to mother and child health are available to provide essential information to the students regarding study.



10. Computer Lab: - It is equipped with a number of computers for training and practice of students to be used for hospital information system.



11. A.V. Aid Lab: - It consists of various electronic

devices like LCD projectors, overhead projectors, T.V., tape recorders, slide projector and V.C.R. for teaching and education purpose for the students.

12. Library: - The College has a spacious well-stocked library with a sitting capacity of 120 students. There are more than 4000 books on various subjects of nursing. Besides this latest national & international journals on nursing are regularly available in the library. Local newspapers & magazines are prescribed for the library for the students.



13. Hostel and Mess Facilities: - Students are expected to stay in the hostel. Hostels are well located and the rooms are available with adequate furniture, hostel mess, dining tables, water purifier and hand washing facilities are available. Telephone and medical facilities like sick room are available in the hostel. Warden of the hostel looks after the student's needs along with servants and security guards. Recreation room with T.V., Newspaper and Magazines and play room with indoor games is provided.



14. Clinical Training: - Practical training is provided to students in government and private hospitals like IGMC, Shimla; ESIC Model Hospital, Baddi; Govt. Mental Hospital, Amritsar; Zonal Hospital, Solan; FRU, Nalagarh and Parent Hospital Lord Mahavira Hospital at Nalagarh & Baddi..



15. Placement of Students: - Pass out students are well placed in esteemed hospitals of India like Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon; Max Hospital & Apollo Hospital, Delhi and Care Partners at Haryana. A campus interview is held every year and brilliant students are placed in esteemed hospitals.



16. Educational tours and picnics are arranged for students.
